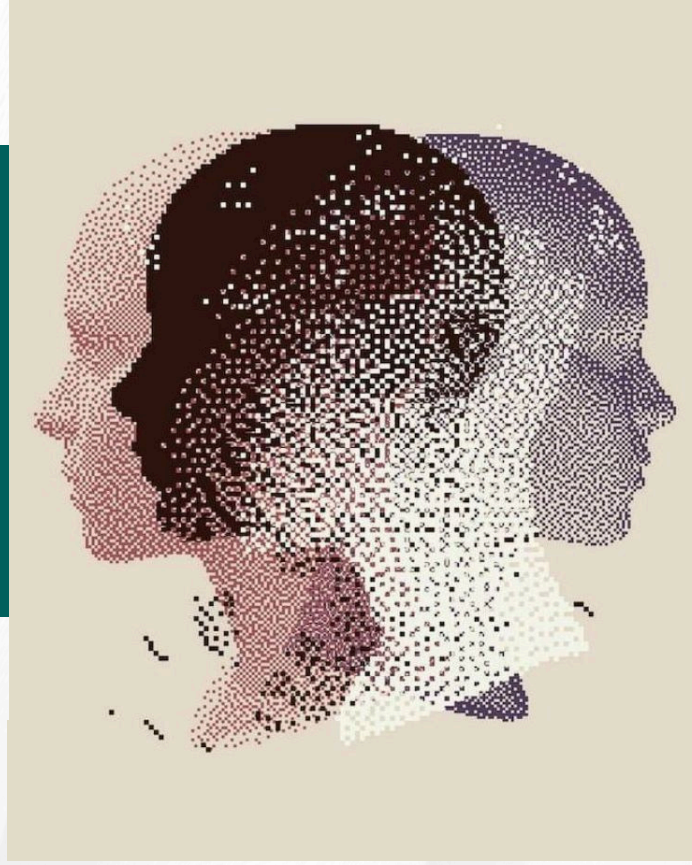

WORKSHOP OUTLINE

Complex Dissociation (CD) is one of the most difficult and frequently misunderstood mental health conditions today.

This workshop brings together leading experts in neurofeedback, Deep Brain Reorienting (DBR), and clinical trauma treatment to share their extensive hands-on experience in addressing CD.

This one-day live workshop will include case study examinations, presentations, a live demonstration and an interactive Q&A session.

KEY LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Examine the key brain mechanisms involved in dissociative experiences among individuals with Complex Dissociation.
- Provide a clear rationale for the use of neuroscience-based approaches in the treatment of individuals with Complex Dissociation.
- Describe the role of neurofeedback in addressing fear and enhancing self-regulation in individuals with complex trauma.
- Discuss the role of Deep Brain Reorienting (DBR) in resolving attachment shock and processing unresolved traumatic experiences, including a live demonstration of DBR.
- Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and engage in discussions to deepen their understanding and explore the practical applications of the innovative treatments presented.
